

Pinot Grigio Single Vineyard 2013



Estate bottled wine, produced from 100% of the Pinot Grigio variety of grapes. Its creation involves the traditional “ramato” method that enables a few hours of contact of the grape juice with the grape skin, resulting in a clear and beautiful grayish yellow color with luminescent golden sparkles. This fresh, dry wine is abundant in its captivating citrus aroma and delicate fruity notes, mostly pears and apples, with subtle subtones of fennel pollen, resin and honeycomb. The taste is full, with a pleasant mineral-citrus freshness, the citrus-fruit hints are tenderly present and the aftertaste is harmonious and palatable.

It is best served while it is still fresh and young, chilled at 7- 10°C, combined with sea fish, salmon starters, pasta in white sauce and chicken meat with steamed vegetables.
