

Ten Barrels Syrah 2010



The uniqueness of this Syrah wine, originating from our own vineyards, is created through double yield reduction that results in a partial dehydration of the grapes on the vine. These amplographic techniques enable obtaining a phenolically ripe wine, with an intense ruby red color and with a high extract and ageing potential. The aroma is complex, fruity and spicy, bursting with hints of berries, chocolate, liquorice and violet. The taste is elegant, full-bodied and long lasting, well structured, with integrated tannins and with a long aftertaste resulting from the 18-month ageing process in new American and French oak barriques.

Best served: 13-17°C. Best combined with various types of meat, especially with game in spicy sauces.

Alcohol: 14,1 % Vol.
