

Merlot Single Vineyard Reserva 2009



A dry red wine produced from 100% carefully selected Merlot grapes. The wine is defined by a remarkable ruby red, vivacious and intense color. The taste is complex, with a fruity character revealing black cherries, blackberry jam and figs complemented with spicy notes of vanilla, smoke and roasted coffee. The complexity of the aroma comes from the 25-month ageing process of the wine in new American and French oak barriques. The taste is rich and full-bodied, with a harmonious acidity, soft velvety tannins and with a long and persistent fruit-and-chocolate aftertaste.

Recommended serving temperature: 15-18°C. Best combined with meat specialties, especially with game in spicy sauces. Decanting prior to use recommended.

Alcohol: 14, 5% Vol.
