

Ten Barrels Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 Reserva



This premium red wine, produced from the Cabernet Sauvignon variety, is defined by a deep ruby red color with dark red hues. It is a genuine reserva with a recognizable, ripe and abundant nose with fruit-and-spice-like character. The wine unveils red berries, black currents and raspberries most, combined with liquorice, dark chocolate, roasted coffee and mint. The remarkable complexity of the wine is a result of the 26-month ageing process in new French and American barriques. The taste is full-bodied, harmonic, with a velvety structure, delicate silky tannins and with a long and pleasurable aftertaste that marks this wine with a special charm.

This wine is best served at 16-18°C. It is perfectly combined with meat specialties, especially with beefsteak in a green pepper sauce, or with game in a spicy sauce.
