

Merlot Single Vineyard Reserva 2007

A premium dry red wine, carefully crafted from 100% Merlot grapes. Distinguished for its intensive and fresh ruby red color, this wine is dynamic, crystal and vivid in the glass. As a result of the 18 months of ageing in new high quality oak barrels, it has evolved into a complex, ripe and structured deep red wine with a clear presence of newly developed tertiary aromatic compounds. The first impression upon tasting gives away its vanilla-smoke combination, but as it gets more aerated, it exposes its spicy and fruity aromas, as a combination of clove and black cherry tones. The taste is full-bodied and harmonic, with high extract and expressive freshness, which further emphasize its strong structure. Even though there is a noticeable presence of tannins, they are well balanced and velvety and carry the potential for a long bottle ageing.

Enjoy it with red meat or game specialties, strong cheeses and a variety of flavorful spicy meals. It is best served at 14-16°C. Decanting prior to serving is highly recommended.
