





A dry white wine produced from delicately selected grapes of the Temjanika variety. It is defined by a hay-like yellow color with a fresh green hue. The charm of this wine is revealed in the elegant and sensual nose, typical for the variety. The dominant fruity aromas of dry apricots and orange peel are followed by discrete spicy subtones of basil and elder which provide the wine with an especially intriguing note. The taste is medium to full-bodied, with harmonic freshness and well balanced, long fruity-spicy aftertaste.

Recommended serving temperature: 8-10°C. Enjoy this wine as an appetitive, combined with light starters, with assorted cookies, apple pie or poached pears.
