

## Pinot Grigio 2011



The wine is produced 100% from the Pinot Grigio variety of grapes grown in the vineyards surrounding the Chateau Kamnik winery. The wine is characterized by a specific hay-like pale color with hues of green. The nose is fresh, typical for the variety and reminds of white fruits, mostly apples and pears. The taste is full-bodied, varietal with a typical freshness, mineral subtones and with a pleasant and harmonious aftertaste.

Best served chilled at 8-10°C, with fresh seafood, salmon starters/appetizers, pasta in a variety of white sauces and chicken meat.
